## ABOUT THE CITEP PROGRAM

The DoD Cyber and Information Technology Exchange Program (CITEP) provides a unique opportunity for DoD and private sector employees working in the information technology (IT) and cybersecurity fields to participate in a temporary detail (between three months and one year) between the two sectors.

## CITEP CAREER DEVELOPMENT

This is an opportunity for you to enhance your IT and cybersecurity competencies and technical skills through defined and meaningful experiences at a private sector organization. Throughout the process you will gain exposure of emerging IT and cybersecurity concepts, strategies, private sector best practices and more.

## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for CITEP you must be a current DoD civilian employee at the General Schedule grade 11 level and above (or equivalent) working in the cybersecurity or IT field. Applicants must also be currently performing at a minimum of the "Fully Successful" performance level and receive an endorsement from their immediate supervisor.
